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
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What's Happening!

What is the **Tdap** vaccine? The Tdap vaccine is a booster shot to protect adolescents and adults against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis or "whooping cough". The Tdap vaccine is routinely given on or after the 10th birthday. A dose of Tdap vaccine given on or after the 7th birthday meets the new school requirements.
