### Rady Children's New North Coastal Location



Rady Children's services are now closer to home for the more than 110,000 children living in the North Coastal region.

On April 4, 2011, Rady Children's opened the doors to a new, comprehensive clinic designed especially for children. The 28,500 square-foot facility, which is designed as a castle, provides a full range of healthcare services for children of all ages, including specialty care, after-hours urgent care, developmental services and behavioral health services.

Rady Children's has consolidated four nearby specialty clinics in order to provide specialty care services all under one roof. In addition to these consolidated services, subspecialty care and an after-hours urgent care clinic are available.

With more than 110,000 children within a 10-mile radius of the clinic, the new facility will provide quality health care that is comprehensive, convenient and close to home for families who previously may have had to travel to our other locations.

# Comprehensive Eating Disorder Program Medical West Unit

Until now, San Diego has not had a medical pediatric inpatient program for patients in need of treatment of anorexia and bulimia.

That all changed with the opening of Rady Children's Medical West Unit, which houses an inpatient program for the treatment of eating disorders in children and adolescents. The eating disorders program uses a three-step model of care and includes elements of the Maudsley Approach. Patients may enter and leave the program at any stage of care depending on their need for treatment. The program includes:

- Medical West Unit for patients needing medical stabilization
- Family-Based Day Treatment providing management of behavioral components
- Outpatient programs ensuring long-term success



The eating disorders program is led by Walter H. Kaye, M.D., Professor of Psychiatry, UC San Diego School of Medicine. The Medical West Unit is staffed by a combination of personnel with medical expertise and with mental health and behavioral experience including child psychiatry. Staff includes nurses, psychologists, social workers, licensed psychiatric technicians, dieticians, and physicians from the both hospitalist and child psychiatry services.

Our goal is to deliver the best medical, psychiatric and nutritional care to help patients recover medically, and to assist with a strong outpatient plan that will ensure a successful recovery.

# Marilyn Jones, MD Honored by Wellesley College Alumnae Association



# Rady Children's Specialists: In the Community Temecula, CA




Great Oak High School's Volleyball Team

In an effort to raise money for Great Oak High School in Temecula, a team of doctors volunteered their time and services for a sports physical clinic on April 16, 2011. Andrew Pennock, M.D., and Eric Edmonds, M.D., both Pediatric and Adolescent Orthopedic Sports Medicine Specialists, were among the physicians who performed physical exams for the more than 350 local high school athletes at Great Oak High.

"Being able to offer our services to residents in Southwest Riverside County is exciting for us," said Edmonds. "This partnership with the Temecula Valley Unified School District allows us to reach out to more young athletes to help reduce sport-related injuries."

Great Oak administrators decided to leverage the sports physicals as a fundraiser for the school's sports medicine program, now in its fourth year. During the four hour sports physicals event the school raised approximately \$7,000, which will fund purchases of supplies such as surgical gloves, bandages and splints for the school's sports medicine program. The program is run by an athletic trainer and 10 students who volunteer their time after school.

"Now more than ever it is vital that the community pull together to ensure the continuation of our sports program for more than 1,400 athletes," said Bobby Arban, the school's athletic director. "It was great to see the physicians and others pull together to support our young athletes."

The sports physicals clinic was organized to help students prepare for summer and fall sports. At Great Oak High, there are more than 1,500 athletes, cheerleaders and dancers.

"It feels really good to know that there are physicians in our community and in San Diego willing to give up their time to help our kids and our programs," added Arban. "When we can get help from the surrounding communities that means a lot to us especially during these tough economic times."
