Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego has taken a major step forward in the research of childhood diseases with the



establishment of the **Rady Pediatric Genomics** and **Systems Medicine Institute at Rady**

Children's. Ernest Rady and family have made yet another extraordinary investment in the health and well-being of children by pledging \$120 million to support pediatric research and innovation at the Institute. The gift is the largest donation ever made to Rady Children's Hospital Foundation. Rady Children's Board of Trustees has committed an additional \$40 million in funding to support the Institute.

"After more than one and one half years of evaluating the design and mission of an Institute at Rady Children's, this Institute will assemble a team of world class scientists, researchers and clinicians who will focus their talents on preventing, diagnosing, treating and curing childhood disease through genomics and systems medicine research," said David F. Hale, Chairman of the Board. "The Institute will work closely with UC San Diego and establish relationships with other academic and research institutions, companies involved in genomics research and other children's hospitals to advance the mission of the Institute," said Hale.

Update on the Ebola Virus



Every news station has the Ebola Outbreak as a leading story. Because of the news coverage, we wanted to give a quick update and overview of what we are doing here at RCHSD.

The Infection Control and Infectious Disease Teams keep a close watch on all potential outbreaks. We have been watching MERS in the Middle East, Ebola in West Africa, Pertussis in California and Avian Flu in Asia. We routinely communicate updates and reminders to RCHSD physicians, our Emergency Department Staff and clinical leadership on current outbreak status and any specific reminders. These reminders include using Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when caring for symptomatic patients and asking questions about recent travel abroad. Our teams also work with SCM to make sure we

have enough PPE available and Pharmacy to have medications available.

The Infection Control and Infectious Disease Teams at RCHSD are here to answer any questions. We will be putting information regarding Ebola on our intranet for easy access. We did this for H1N1. Neuro-NICU Program at Rady Children's



The Neuro-NICU Program aims to prevent brain injury in infants through detecting and preventing neurological problems, such as seizures. Under the direction of MJ Harbert, M.D., the Neuro-NICU Program is the only one of its kind in Southern California and one of only 10 such programs in the country. Dr. Harbert, who leads an expert team of neurologists, is one of approximately 30 neonatal

neurointensivists in the world.

In our program, infants who are exhibiting signs of seizures, such unstable vital signs or lack of alertness, are immediately put on an electroencephalogram (EEG) to check their brain's electrical activity. If they begin to have seizures, they are treated with anticonvulsant medication. We also have a large computer server for our EEGs with protected online access, which enables our doctors to monitor brain signals remotely. As a result, we can spot a seizure even when we're not physically at the hospital.

Severe Skin Diseases in Children Beyond Topical Therapy



Congratulations to Dr. Wynnis Tom as the editor for the new book entitled: "Severe Skin Diseases in Children". Dr. Tom is part of the Dermatology Division at Rady Children's Specialists and is also Associate Clinical Professor in the Departments of Pediatrics and Medicine at UCSD.

This textbook is designed as a practical clinical reference that will guide practitioners in treating difficult dermatoses in children in whom topical therapy has been unsuccessful. Individual sections are devoted to inflammatory diseases, immune-mediated/autoimmune diseases, tumors and proliferative disorders, and genodermatoses. Each chapter addresses which patients represent suitable candidates for systemic or other non-

approaches. Potential treatments are then appraised from a current evidence-based perspective, with provision of detailed but relevant information and reference tables that summarize recommendations in use and monitoring. Future directions in management are also presented.
