Mid-City Behavioral Health Urgent Care Now Open

Rady Children's opened its new Behavioral Health Urgent Care (BHUC) in December 2016, which serves children ages 5-17 (covered by Medi-Cal and private insurance) in the Mid-City (San Diego) community and surrounding area. The BHUC is for children, teens and their families struggling with urgent emotional and/or behavioral concerns that pose a risk to their safety or the safety of others. A walk-in clinic is available from 4 -8 p.m., Monday through Friday; daytime hours from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. are available for



appointments for crisis and case management, and referrals to community providers and resources for follow-up treatment.

The goal of the urgent care is to provide prompt access to risk assessment and crisis intervention to minimize the need for children and teens to be sent to the emergency department or psychiatric hospitals. Beginning in April 2017 obstetricians can refer high-risk moms-to-be the Comprehensive Prenatal Center at Rancho Springs Medical Center. Staffed by maternal-fetal experts from Rady Children's Specialists, a division of Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego, the Center offers the following services for both outpatients and inpatients:

- Consultations
- Non-stress testing
- Comprehensive ultrasounds
- Fetal echocardiograms
- Amniocentesis and other genetic testing
- Chorionic villus sampling (CVS)
- First trimester screening/nuchal translucency screening
- California prenatal screening tests (for positive AFP
- referrals)

A management agreement has been signed between Pioneers Memorial Healthcare District (PMHD) and Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego (RCHSD) which will provide management services to the Pediatric and Neonatal Intensive Care Units at Pioneers Memorial Hospital.



Under the new agreement, Rady Children's will provide a medical director and a nursing leader to deliver clinical administrative services. Also the agreement stipulates all hospital beds remain under PMHD license and Rady Children's is responsible for medical management.

This new agreement will improve communications and clinical guidelines between the two facilities which will allow the very best quality of care to children.
