SEPTEMBER 14 & 15, 2020 ADOS-2 INTRODUCTORY CLINICAL WORKSHOP

This two day workshop will teach you how to assess and diagnose autism spectrum disorders (ASD) using the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule, Second Edition (ADOS-2). You will have the opportunity to practice scoring and watch as an experienced workshop leader administers the ADOS-2 to a child with ASD. This workshop is designed for professionals unfamiliar with the ADOS-2 and will focus on Modules 1-4. Participants are required to bring their ADOS-2 Manual. ADOS protocols and DVDs will be provided.
