


10 Simple Rules for creating your own social story!

- 1. Make a title page
- 2. Drag or copy paste photos into place in sequential order
- 3. Add text to describe each photo
- 4. Avoid negative statements, keep explanations simple and in first person
- 5. Use real pictures when possible (it is okay to use simple drawings or cartoon pictures as well)
- 6. Keep it to the point and include things your child likes
- 7. Make it fun and inviting
- 8. Always end on a positive note (e.g., mommy will be proud of me; I will get a prize, etc.)
- 9. Include at least one real photo of your child if possible
- 10. Read the story before the visit to the hospital and bring it with you to remind your child what is going to happen




